

Vista Security Screens Care and Maintenance

Periodic cleaning of your Vista Security Screens will extend the life and beauty of your screens.

Dust, dirt and airborne particulates will cause visual obstructions to the Stainless Steel Mesh which may lead to corrosion or staining of the mesh and aluminum powder coated finishes.

Typical cleaning will vary depending upon the environment.

Inland areas will require cleaning every 3 to 6 months and coastal areas will require every 2 to 4 weeks where sea salt spray exists.

Wash the screen and door frame with a mild detergent using a soft brush on both sides of mesh and door frame. Avoid exposing the locking hardware and handles to excessive amount of water. Dry and remove excess water from mesh and door frame. Do not use any abrasive materials on the mesh or door frame.

Use white grease lubricant on hinges after each cleaning. Use a dry lube spray that is designated "Dirt & Dust Resistant with PTFE" on lock and lock mechanism at least once a year or when necessary.
